Eichmann in Jerusalem, By Hannah Arendt. (In Xerox). - Arendt followed the Eichmann trial in April and June 1961 as a trial observer for The New Yorker magazine. She published her impressions almost two years later in five consecutive issues of The New Yorker. The prel. book published in 1963 is a slightly expanded and modified version of the text. Between 1963 and 1965, the book appeared in four different versions in five printings. Compared to the first English edition, extensive changes were made in the German translation in 1964, which were also adopted in the American paperback edition in 1965. The most important was the change to her thesis, according to which the number of victims could have been lower.

Behrens, together with his wife Lilli (1869-1959), who mainly designed and produced clothing, textiles and decorated papers, lived at the Mathildenhöhe artists' colony until 1903.

Brocade paper was historically often referred to as "Augsburg paper" and had its heyday in the first half of the 18th century. The main centres of production were Augsburg and Nuremberg. 





First edition. Written in less than a month, The Bibliomania marks "the first full flowering of Dibdin's love affair with books" (Windle and Pippin, p. 35). Thomas Froggnall Dibdin (1776-1847), English bibliographer, clergyman and inveterate book-lover, was a lively and engaging writer whose works enjoyed great popularity and helped to stimulate enthusiasm for book collecting in the nineteenth century. 

Paul Heineken (1674-1746) was a painter, graphic artist and architect from Riga, whose "Lucidum Perspectivae speculum" provided an important foundation for 18th century perspective theory. The frontispiece and the engraved plates are by Georg David Nessenthaler (1695-1736) after designs by Heineken. The last plates show, as announced on the title, "Plafonds oder Decken-Stücke von diversen Sorten". Furthermore, perspective depictions of church interiors and antique ruins are also shown. A second edition was published by Lotter in Augsburg in 1753.

This second album shows almost exclusively building damage and 12 other photographs: Japan Press Service Photo, Dec. 13, 1960. - The USA sent hundreds of scientists and doctors to Hiroshima and Nagasaki after the two atomic bombs to document the consequences. A large part of the later compiled collections might probably come from this material.







Sabin 35.739; De Backer-S. IV, 754, 2; Fromm III, 386 - First latin edition. The original French edition was published in Leiden in 1648. Pierre Jarrige (1604-1660 or 1670), was initially a Jesuit, he later taught grammar, humanities and rhetoric in Bordeaux. He converted to Calvinism in La Rochelle in 1647, defended his apostasy in Leyden. Sentenced to hanging and the burning of his body in La Rochelle, he wrote the diatribe, which was followed by an even more venomous one after the Jesuits replied. (cf. Lexikon f. Theologie und Kirche, vol. V, 287) - A German edition was published in 1761 with the title 'Nachricht von den vielen Lastern, welche die Jesuiten in der Provinz Guienne begangen haben (...) Der Jesuiten Geilheit in ihren Classen; ihre Geilheit bei Besuch, in ihren Häusern, in Kirchen, auf Reisen, auf dem Lande und in Nonnenklöstern'. (Hayn-Got. III, 408).

The physician Jean de Carro (1770-1857) came from a distinguished Geneva family. In 1799, he successfully vaccinated his two sons against smallpox with cowpox lymph for the first time on the European mainland and was elevated to the nobility by Emperor Franz I for his efforts. The dedicatee Aleksandra Franciszka Rzewuska (nicknamed Rosalia), née Lubomirska (1788-1865) was the daughter of Prince Aleksander Lubomirski (1754-1804) and Rozalia Chodkiewicz (1768-1794), who was executed for alleged espionage during the French Revolution. Rosalia Rzewuska was a member of the Order of the Star Cross, which still exists today. It can be assumed that she was personally acquainted with Jean de Carro.
